Why New patients need to bring **Birth Certificate** and **Legal Guardian Paper**?

To prove that the person bringing the Child into the office for the first visit is a legal parent/guardian

Parent's ID /Driver License must match name of the parent on the birth certificate.

If parent does not bring in the birth certificate than we must reschedule the appointment until parent can bring in the birth certificate.

If grandmother or any other person whom is NOT the legal parent brings the child in for the first appointment it is our responsibility to reschedule the appointment until legal parent/guardian can bring the child.

If child is in a person's care whom is not the legal parent then birth certificate and the legal papers stating the adult person bringing the child for care is the legal guardian/authorized to approve care.
